The XXII International Workshop on Deep Inelastic Scattering and Related Subjects, DIS2014, will be hosted by the Faculty of Physics, University of Warsaw, Polish Physical Society and National Centre for Nuclear Research. It will take place in Warsaw, Poland, from April 28 (Monday) to May 2 (Friday), 2014. As usual, the first day will be devoted to plenary review talks, followed by three days of parallel sessions and summary talks the last day. The workshop will be preceded by a popular scientific session for general public and students on Sunday, April 27. A preliminary web page of the Workshop is at: http://dis2014.fuw.edu.pl. The page will be regularly updated as new information becomes available.

The aim of these annual workshops is to review the progress of DIS and QCD and to lay groundwork for future experiments. In particular most recent results from CERN, BNL, DESY, FNAL and JLab as well as the relevant theoretical developments will be covered. DIS2014 is expected to bring together about 300 experimentalists and theorists.

Registration for DIS2014 will soon be opened and we encourage those of you who are planning to attend to register as soon as possible. The deadline for the early registration and payment is March 1, 2014. Reduced registration fee will be available for students.

Requesting talks at the parallel sessions of DIS2014 will be opened on January 1, 2014. Please contact via e-mail the conveners of an appropriate working group.
