DIS 2014, XXII. International Workshop on Deep-Inelastic Scattering and Related Subjects will be held from **April 28 to May 2, 2014** at the Old Library of the University of Warsaw. It is organized by the University of Warsaw, the Polish Physical Society and National Centre for Nuclear Research.

The conference will be preceded by a popular session **“Secrets of the Particle World”**, on **April 27, afternoon**, opened for schools, students and the wider community.

General

Venue

The conference and the open session will be held at the main campus of the University of Warsaw in the Old Library Building. The address is: 26/28 Krakowskie Przedmieście str.

Registration

Registration desk will be open on April, 27 (14:00-19:00) and on April, 28 (8:00-14:30) in the Old Library Building. Late arrivals will be registered at the conference secretariat.

Facilities

Multimedia and overhead projectors, as well as wireless access to Internet (including eduroam) are available at the conference site.

Talks

All presentations should be uploaded to Indico, preferably in PDF format. We request that all speakers submit their transparencies two hours before the session block of their presentation (that is on the evening before for morning sessions and before the lunch break for afternoon sessions). No private laptops or USB memory sticks will be allowed for presentations. Please avoid animations and other special effects which may not be displayed correctly in a lecture room.

Currency

The name of the monetary unit in Poland is zloty, abbreviated as zł or PLN. Approximate exchange rates are $1 \text{ PLN} \approx 0.33 \text{ USD} \approx 0.24 \text{ EUR}$.

will be held on April, 28 (8:30 -19:00) and May, 2 (9:00 - 18:00) in the Main Lecture Hall.

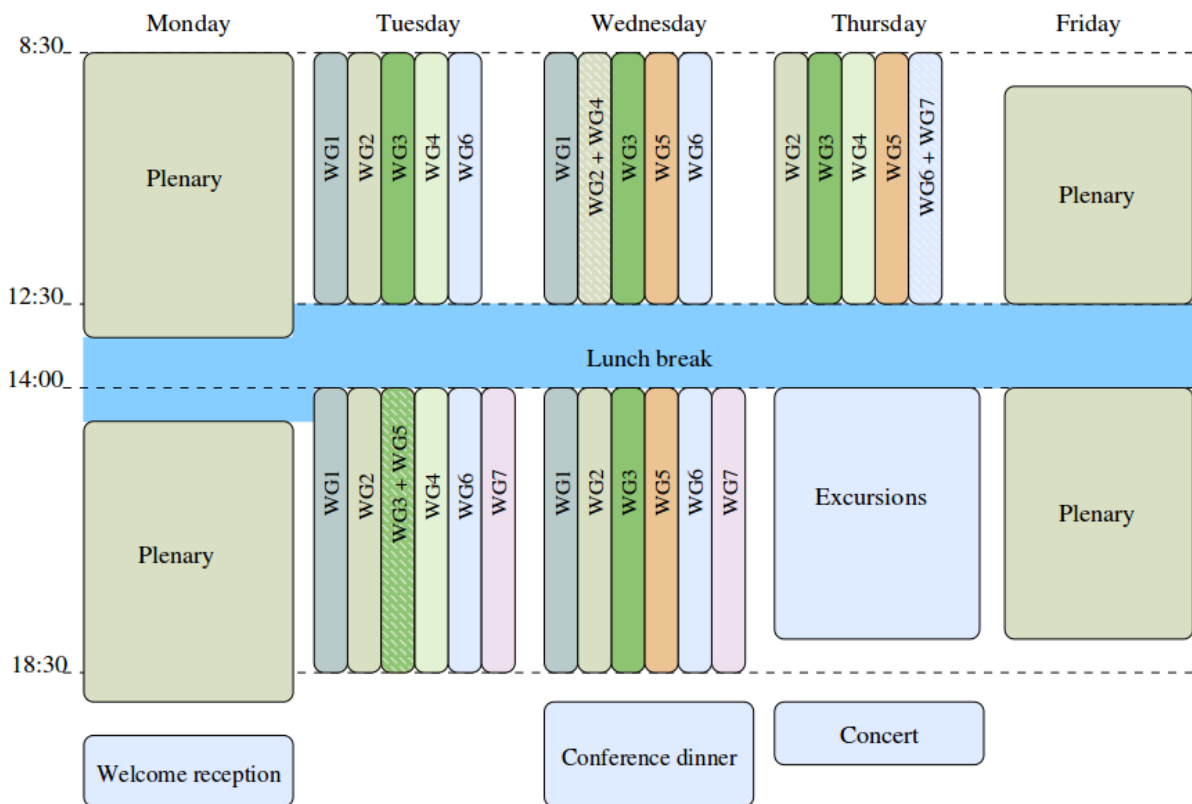
Parallel sessions

will be held on April 29, 30 and May 1 (8:30-18:30) in the Main Lecture Hall and seminar rooms on the first floor.

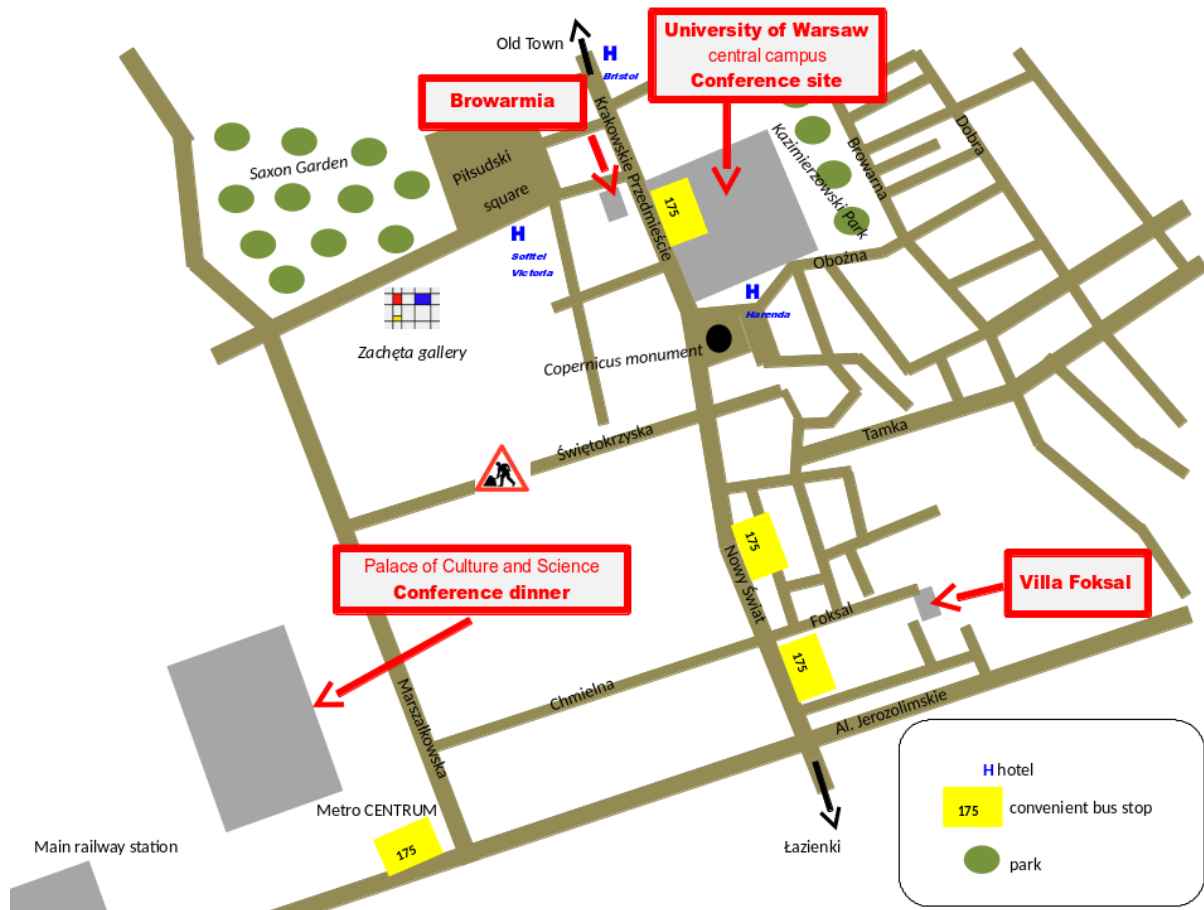
Open session

Important notice!

The city is undergoing a series of improvements, e.g. construction of a new subway line, road and street works; therefore certain streets may be inaccessible.

Travel (arriving by plane)

The Frederic Chopin Airport is located about 10 km from the city centre.

Bus

lines 148, 175 and 188 connect the airport with the nearby residential districts and the city centre. The bus stop is located just outside the arrival hall. Tickets should be purchased at vending machines located at bus stops or at the Passenger Service Centre in the arrival hall.

To the conference site: direct line 175; get out at UNIWERSYTET (~35 min.)

To your hotel: line 175 takes you to most downtown hotels (e.g. Polonia Palace, Metropol, Novotel, Bristol, Sofitel Victoria, Harena, Mercure Grand, Dom Chłopa);

To the university guesthouse SOKRATES: bus 175 or 188; get out at SASANKI (~6 min.) and then continue with bus 189 or 401 (get out at AL. LOTNIKÓW (~10 min.));

To the university guesthouse HERA: bus 188 (get out at POMNIK LOTNIKA) and then change to bus 167 (get out at SPACEROWA).

A taxi is recommended in the last two cases.

Taxi

stand is available just outside the arrival hall. Use only certified companies: Super Taxi, Sawa Taxi and Ele Taxi. Do not use transportation offered by unauthorized persons. A trip to the city centre costs ~**40 PLN**.

Trains S2

depart from a station located to the right of the arrival hall, behind a construction site. Tickets are available from vending machines; there is a staff on duty to help you with the purchase and transfer. Trains run to a railway station in the centre; the stop is called WARSZAWA ŚRÓDMIEŚCIE (about 25 min.).

Travel (arriving by train)

Main railway station, WARSZAWA CENTRALNA, is in the strict city centre.

Bus

to conference site: line 175; get out UNIWERSYTET (~15 min.).

To your hotel: line 175 takes you to most hotels (e.g. Sofitel Victoria, Novotel, Bristol, Metropol, Polonia Palace, Harena, Mercure Grand, Dom Chłopa).

Taxi

stand is located outside the station, follow signs on platforms and underground passages. Use only certified companies (with a phone number on the car or "radio taxi"), make sure that the ride is metered and check the rates (must be displayed in the car). A ride to the conference site costs ~20 PLN.

Walk

Many downtown hotels (e.g. Novotel Centrum, Metropol, Polonia Palace) are within walking distance from WARSZAWA CENTRALNA. Check on the map.

Travel (from your hotel to the conference site)

The following general suggestions may be helpful to reach the conference site by public transport.

From downtown:

many downtown hotels are located close to WARSZAWA CENTRALNA (central station) or bus stop CENTRUM. Bus line 175 runs from there to a stop called UNIWERSYTET (~15 min.) located at the conference site.

From guesthouse HERA:

Bus stop is located in front of the building. Many bus lines run to the central University campus (bus stop UNIWERSYTET), e.g. bus 116.

From guesthouse SOKRATES:

Subway from station SŁUŻEW to a station POLITECHNIKA (~8 min.) or tram line 10 to a stop BIELAŃSKA then a bus line 222 to a stop UNIWERSYTET (~14 min.);

alternative: subway to a station CENTRUM (10 min.) then bus line 175 to a stop UNIWERSYTET (13 min.);

alternative: subway to a station ŚWIĘTOKRZYSKA (12 min.) then walk (20 min.).

Tickets and taxi rates

Tickets for public transport

valid for all Warsaw buses, trams, metro and S2 trains, can be purchased at the vending machines (English instructions available) and at newsstands.

In zone 1 (alternatively zone 1 and 2) a single fare transfer ticket valid for 75 min. (90 min.) costs PLN 4.40 (PLN 7), 1-day ticket: PLN 15 (PLN 26). A ticket valid 20-min. In zone 1 and 2 costs PLN 3.40 (<http://www.ztm.waw.pl/index.php?c=608&l=2>).

Taxi rate

A typical one is ~3 PLN per km, with 50% late-night and weekend surcharge; the initial rate is around 8 PLN.

Social events

Welcome reception

Monday, April 28, 19:30 – 21:30, at “Browarmia”, a restaurant and brewery, about 300 m from the University campus, see enclosed map.

Conference dinner
